
Brue Bog Oak

Bog Oak (also known as Black Oak and Morta) – one of the most exclusive and rarest materials in the world. It is estimated that there is less of it on Earth than diamonds. Formed over thousands of years from submerged logs, which take on a naturally black color as a consequence of chemical processes. The eldest bog oak log we processed was 6300 years old.



Duraj's Wood has mastered the processing of this inestimable value timber to perfection – we can dry immense elements without breaking them into pieces. Creating bespoke masterpieces out of this precious material made us recognizable among many manufacturers working within wooden industry, interior designers and architects from all around the world.







RARELY FOUND AMONG FLOORS: End Grain

Another product that makes Durai's Wood stand out is the end grain flooring. When embarking on projects, it is important to understand the differences in log cutting. End grain is the grain of wood seen when the log is cut at a 90 degrees, exposing growth rings on every distinctive piece. End grain cuts bring out highly-aesthetic wooden slabs of art with character.




End grain tiles are an exeptional form of flooring that has been used for decades due to one particular reason: durability. End grain floors were traditional floor coverings in places with heavy traffic, where they were exposed to intense surface abrasion. The way grains are placed allows them to absorb energy and noise, and the angle of cut allows for the growth rings to resist scraping and general wear.



1. WOOD SPECIES SELECTION

The process of creating the perfect wooden floor begins with the choice of wood species. We can source any of them, but the most popular are the three best-sellers: European Oak, European Ash, American Walnut and the completely distinctive Bog Oak. When deciding, pay attention to the unique grain and colors of each one of them. We value not only the highest quality but also the sustainability of the timber we provide, that is why Duraj's Wood has been working with the same trusted suppliers for over three decades.









2. COLOR

The color of the floorboards depends on the type of wood our clients select. Each type looks best in colors matching its natural grain and tone. 


GRADE	DESCRIPTION	EUROPEAN OAK
CLEAR	 The cleanest selection with as little color variation as possible. Rare, healthy pin-knots (<5 mm) permissible. Sapwood and natural cracks unacceptable. 	
SELECT	 A clean selection with as little color variation as possible. Occasional sound knots (< 15 mm) permissible. Sapwood and natural cracks unacceptable. 	
RUSTIC	Natural selection with natural color variation. Healthy knots allowed (< 50 mm), occasional natural cracks and holes. Sapwood unacceptable.	
COUNTRY	Natural selection with natural color variation. Healthy knots allowed (< 50 mm), occasional natural cracks and holes. Sapwood unacceptable.	











Long line of straight arrows first seen in the 16th century. Available in custom sizes.








KNOT PANEL

Most commonly found in medieval castles.




FANG PANEL

Inspired by H15 Luxury Palace in Cracow.




ENDLESS DIAMOND PARQUET

Equilateral rhombus – simple, yet impressive.




ENDLESS DOUBLE - DIAMOND PARQUET

Mixing colors makes this pattern look like an optical illusion




ENDLESS TRAPEZE PARQUET

Adds three-dimensionality to the flooring.




ENDLESS VERSAILLES PARQUET







Transferring the classic basket weaving technique to the floor.










A beveled edge or bevel for short is an edge of a structure that is not perpendicular to the faces of the board. The words bevel and chamfer overlap in usage.





Boards subjected to 3 - 7 machine grinding cycles for gentle and smooth to touch surface.




Boards with 2 - 4 machine brushing cycles to obtain surfaces with slightly visible wood structure.





Boards subjected to 4 – 7 mechanical brushing cycles to obtain a surface with a rough and clear structure.



Boards very heavily dried to obtain a raw surface with a clear to see and feel structure.
















Our approach towards nature
